### **Evaluation of the applicant's scholarly/artistic qualifications**

The research activity doc. Ing. Šárka Laboutková, Ph.D. within the field of Economic Policy focuses on the role of interest groups and their influence on decision-making processes in the creation of economic policy, on corruption, the quality of governance and the importance of an institutional environment for the effectiveness of economic policy. These research topics, developed by doc. Laboutková are up-to-date, in line with the focus of the field of Economic Policy and also correspond to the social demand, which is evidenced by her publication outputs and obtained grant projects. She published results of her activities in about 60 papers, where 9 papers are indexed in the WoS database and 4 papers in Scopus. She participated in the creation of 4 monographs, one of which was a foreign monograph and she contributed four times with her own chapter(s) to the elaboration of other scientific monographs. She has published 17 conference papers, indexed in WoS and 18 peer-reviewed professional articles. She presented her expert opinions six times at the requested lectures. Her works have been cited more than 70 times in the WoS and Scopus databases. The practical significance of her research activities was also confirmed by the acquisition of 6 projects of the Grant Agency of the Czech Republic (once as the main researcher) and one project of the Technological Agency of the Czech Republic.

**Conclusion:** The applicant's scholarly/artistic capabilities **meet** the requirements expected of applicants participating in a professor appointment procedure in the field of Economic Policy.

### **Evaluation of the applicant's pedagogical experience**

In 1999 Doc. Laboutková started her teaching activity at the University of Economics in Prague and continued it at the Faculty of Economics of the Technical University in Liberec, where she still works. In 2012, she was habilitated as an associate professor in the field of Economics at Faculty of Economics of VSB – Technical University in Ostrava.

She lectures at the follow-up master's degree studies in Czech and English on the subjects of Economic Policy II and Macroeconomics II, which she is also a guarantor of, and on the subject of Public Policy, where she also conducts seminars. She created the subject of Institutional Environment for Business at the doctoral degree study, which she lectures on. She is a guarantor of the follow-up academically focused study program called "Economic Policy in the Global Environment". During her previous work at the Faculty of Economics at the Technical University in Liberec, she has led about 40 diploma theses and is a member of the commissions for state final examinations at bachelor's and follow-up master's degrees and a member of doctoral examination commissions at the Faculty of Economics at the Technical University in Liberec, Faculty of International Relations of the University of Economics in Prague and the Masaryk University Faculty of Economics and Administration in Brno.

She has been a supervisor of 5 doctoral students (of which 2 doctoral students have already successfully completed their studies). She is a co-author of 3 textbooks and the author of 2 e-learning teaching texts.

**Conclusion:** The applicant's pedagogical capabilities **meet** the requirements expected of applicants participating in a professor appointment procedure in the field of Economic Policy.

### **Evaluation of the applicant as a respected and recognized scholarly or artistic figure in a given field**

Ms. Associate Professor has been profiling herself in the field of Economic Policy for a long time and achieves relevant results, which she has also presented in the international field at professional conferences. She is a member of the Scientific Board and the Council for Internal Evaluation of the Faculty of Economics at the Technical University in Liberec and the Academic Board of the PRIGO University in Havířov. She is a permanent member of the Accreditation Commission for the field of Economics and an evaluator of the National Accreditation Authority. She is also a member of several professional societies: the Czech Economic Society, the Czech Society for Political Sciences, the International

Association of Political Sciences, the European Consortium for Political Research and the Italian Society of Public Economics. In 2003 she received the Rector's Award of the University of Economics in Prague for co-authorship of a prestigious publication and in 2018 the Dean's Award of the Technical University in Liberec for authorship of a prestigious publication in the category of professional journals.

**Conclusion:** The applicant **is** a respected and recognized scholarly figure in his/her field. The applicant **has** made a significant contribution to the development of his/her field. The applicant **constitutes** a leading figure in his/her field of scholarship or research.
