Evaluation of the applicant's scholarly/artistic qualifications

Doc. MUDr. Tomáš Novotný, Ph.D. has been the first or corresponding author of 16 original articles including 12 in journals listed in the WoS database (3 in the first quartile and 1 in the second quartile) and the first author of 6 review articles. Further, he is co-author of another 20 articles (including 19 in journals listed in the WoS database – 9 in the Q1 and 2 in the Q2). He was the principal investigator of 7 research grants supported by Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports; one of these grants has been nominated for the Ministerial Award.

Doc. Novotný's articles have been cited 241-times according to the WoS database (H-index 9)

Conclusion: The applicant's scholarly/artistic capabilities **meet** the requirements expected of applicants participating in a professor appointment procedure in the field of Internal Medicine.

Evaluation of the applicant's pedagogical experience

Doc. MUDr. Tomáš Novotný, Ph.D. has a long time pedagogical experience, he has been involved in the teaching of medical students since the year 2000 in the field of internal medicine and cardiology. He has supervised or currently supervising 5 doctoral students, one of them defended her thesis in 2012. Doc. Novotný is author or co.author of several teaching texts and he participates also in postgraduate teaching courses in the field of arrhythmology.

Conclusion: The applicant's pedagogical capabilities **meet** the requirements expected of applicants participating in a professor appointment procedure in the field of Internal Medicine.

Evaluation of the applicant as a respected and recognized scholarly or artistic figure in a given field

Doc. MUDr. Tomáš Novotný, Ph.D. he is one of the leading national specialists in the field of familial electrical diseases of the heart. Since 1998; he has substantially contributed to introduction of complex diagnostics (both clinical and genetic) of familial electrical diseases of the heart in our country. These activities were supported by several grants from the Ministry of Health and Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports; doc. Novotný was the principal investigator in 7 of them. He is regularly being invited to lecture about this topic. As a confirmation of his position on the field, in 2020 he was elected the historically first chairman of the Cardiogenetic section of the Czech Society of Cardiology.

Conclusion: The applicant **is** a respected and recognized scholarly figure in his/her field. The applicant **has** made a significant contribution to the development of his/her field. The applicant **constitutes** a leading figure in his/her field of scholarship or research.
