The applicant presented a broad overview of challenges in network monitoring / security. Despite a popular level of the talk, it was apparent that the applicant has deep understanding of the presented topics.

The talk was given in English, was well structured, accompanied by examples and the speaker managed to keep attention and interest of the audience during the presentation.

On the negative side, the committee expected more scientific depth and stronger connection to state-of-the-art research and own results. The slides had several weaknesses, for example, graphs without properly described axes. The candidate exceeded the given time slot.

The applicant answered several questions from the audience. The talk was delivered to the public in a hybrid way – most of the audience were present in the auditorium while two members of the committee (prof. Tůma and prof. Rossow) were connected remotely via MS-Teams.
